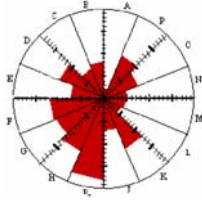
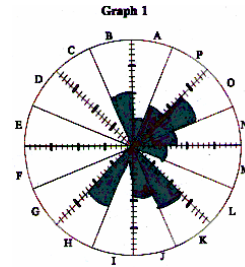

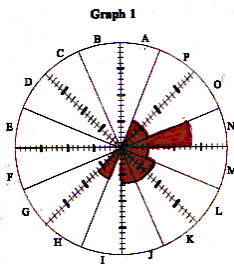

## Takes care of others but with resentment (male)



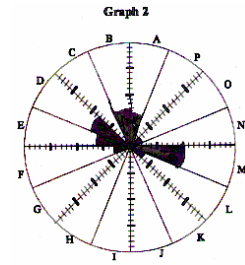

## Lacking aggression – helping others (male)



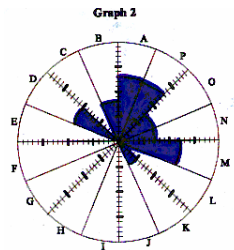

## Victim of marital abuse (female)



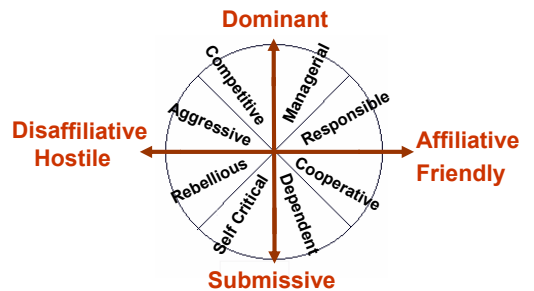

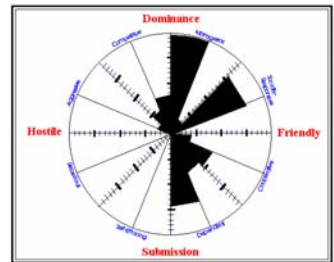

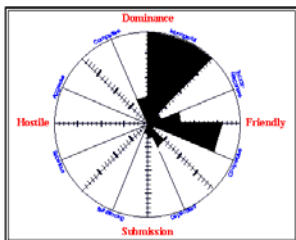

- Where's the hostile side?



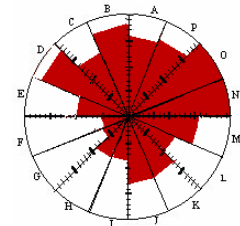
# Example 2
